Such situation may lead a possibility that the legal practice would be more expanded to various area with less cost.</p> <p>On the other hand, would the lawyers or other legal practitioners be replaced by such technology or AI systems? This session should provide very interesting topics and fruitful information to the attendance through the presentation and discussion among the speakers from various countries, such as what knowledge, skills or know-how the new technology era require to the legal practitioners.</p>
