1990年代初めから、アジアでも多くの国が、それまでの社会主義・計画経済体制から、市場経済化とグローバルな経済活動への参加に向けて、民商事分野の法整備、司法機関強化やADR整備などの制度改革を進めてきました。 このプロセスには、国際機関や二国間の援助も深く関わっています。 このセッションでは、この四半世紀の間の取り組みの成果を振り返り、アジアの経済発展との関連を検証しつつ、民事法の適用と執行の現状及び今後の課題を考えます。		Since early 1990s, many countries in Asia have experienced significant changes and reforms from socialistic regime and planned economy towards the market-oriented and globalized economy, including development of the civil and commercial laws, enhancement of civil justice and ADR. Some countries have received legal technical assistances by international donors in the reform process. This session explores the paths and outcomes of these changes and interventions during this quarter century, as well as the current situation and future challenges of implementation and enforcement of these laws.
